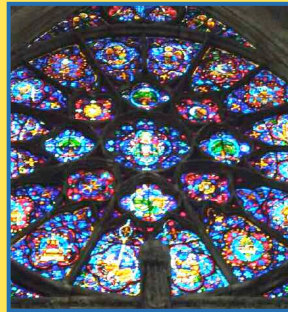


Paris - Chartres - Angers - Reims

FRANCE IS AN EXQUISITELY TEXTURED TAPESTRY... AND A MULTI-LAYERED FEAST TO BOOT

Our intimately-scaled tour explores the en-spirited mind of the Middle Ages, and marvels at its foundational imagery for contemporary Christian belief. Expert interpretation will teach us to 'read' both the architecture and the iconography of such magnificent Gothic SITES as the BASILICA of ST. DENIS, NOTRE DAME de PARIS, and the world-renowned CHARTRES CATHEDRAL.

We will study ST. CHAPELLE'S luminous stained glass, and see a rare 'Vierge Ouvrant' in the NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE MIDDLE AGES at the Thermes de Cluny, home also of the famed 'LADY AND THE UNICORN' tapestries.

We will day-trip by TGV down the Loire Valley to ANGERS to view the stunningly unique 'APOCALYPSE TAPESTRIES' displayed in a 13th century castle, and in the afternoon experience the cosmic CHANT de MONDE weavings by contemporary artist Jean Lurcat.

And we will visit REIMS, the heart of the Champagne region, where we will explore a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE site, the elegant NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL, where the Kings of France were crowned. In Reims we also view the astounding interior of the pre-Gothic ST. REMY BASILICA. And we will celebrate our journey with a tour of a noted CHAMPAGNE CAVE, complete with complimentary samples.

Sally Peabody of Your Great Days in Paris leads this spirited week-long tour with her husband and co-leader, the Reverend Dr. Rand Peabody. Our private resource people will include Elaine Polley, a Paris-based specialist in the Middle Ages, and an expert guide in Angers.

Included: Accommodation in a charming three-star superior hotel in St. Germain des Prés. Metro tickets in Paris, TGV train to Angers, minivans to Chartres and Reims. Private guides. Daily breakfast and multi-course bistro meal with wine. Museum, other admission and activity fees. Airfare to Paris and airport transfers are not included.

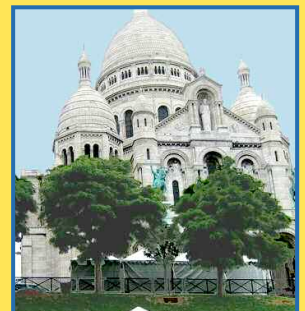

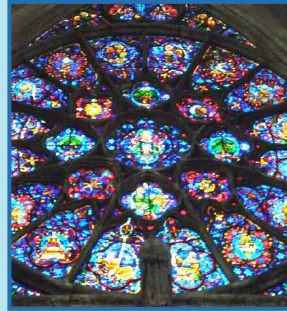
